## Resurfacing Method:

Follow the steps below to take the ball back to "out of the box" condition. Items needed: 500-grit Abralon pad, 2000-grit Abralon pad, a ball spinner and water. All sanding should be done on four sides of the ball. Side one-center of grip up, flip the ball 180 degrees for side two, turn 90 degrees for side three and flip another 180 degrees for side four.

1. Using the 500 -grit Abralon pad, sand the ball for 15 seconds on each side.
2. Using the 2000-grit Abralon pad, sand the ball for 60 seconds each side.

## Suggested Maintenance:



Storm suggests using Reacta Clean ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Reactive Bowling Ball Cleaner to clean your bowling ball after every bowling session.
To touch up the surface, skip step land just use step 2 . Storm suggests using step 2 every $20-30$ games and both steps every 50-60 games. This will increase longevity and create a more consistent reaction for your new Storm bowling ball.
