

## Speed Zone Tour edition 1; Red Pin

This ball has the same core as the LT-48 but has a much weaker cover (similar to the Deep Purple Rhino Pro or the D2Z Tour edition 2). This ball should prove useful when the LT-48 has been working well on a condition and the lanes break down causing the LT-48 to go too early and be weak down the lane. It also should be a good ball when the lanes are hooking but you're looking for a ball that will get rolling fairly heavy, fairly early and gives more of a hard arc type of look versus a skid snap type of look. Any drilling pattern you like will find utility in the TE1.
