CAROLYN DORIN WITH EBONITE TURBO X WINS \$70,000 LADY EBONITE CLASSIC

Carolyn Dorin of Richardson, Texas, was the top seed going into Thursday's stepladder finals televised on ESPN. Dorin, vying for her first singles title, beat Ebonite staff member, Aleta Sill, 216 to 207. Both Dorin and Sill used the **EBONITE TURBO X** bowling ball during the T.V. finals. Dorin went 19 and 5 in match play and received a 1st place check of \$12,600.

Aleta Sill qualified 5th going into the T.V. stepladder finals. In the first game, she defeated Dana Miller-Mackie 266 to 216. In the second game, Sill bowled against and defeated Wendy MacPherson in a very close match of 233 to 232. In the semi-final game, Sill defeated Anne Marie Duggan 268 to 228 to set up her title match against Dorin. By finishing 2nd, Sill from Dearborn, Michigan, earned \$6,300. Fellow Ebonite Staff Members -- Leanne Barrette finished 6th place earning \$2,450 (just 54 pins behind 5th place); and Michelle Mullen finished 11th place for \$1,953.
