On a heavily oiled pattern with moderate carry-down, the Vertigo™ revved up strong in the mid-lane and made a dramatic turn at the break point. We were very surprised on how much of a backend reaction this ball had despite the dull surface. We then polished the Vertigo™ up to 1500-grit, and the ball just snapped harder on the backend. The ball still had good friction with the mid-lane but the breakpoint moved down another 3-4 feet. We loved how the 10-pin "snapped" out with every solid pocket hit. ★★★★

Core Versatility: Storm has a brand new weight block design, the Modified Inverted RAD<sup>3</sup> Triple Disk Technology™. They have taken the weight blocks from their Master line and modified it slightly to create a ball that rolls well in the mid-lane and still finishes on the backend. With this very dynamic asymmetrical core design, be cautious with your layout. A right hander will need to keep the RAD at least 2" right of the ball track to take full advantage of the weight block. ★★★★

Performance/Price: Everyone is sure to see the benefits of buying the Vertigo™. Higher average bowlers must definitely make room in their bag for this ball. I predict that this ball will be the first out of the bag for a large percentage of bowlers. A premium priced ball, the Vertigo™ is well worth the investment. ★★★★★


