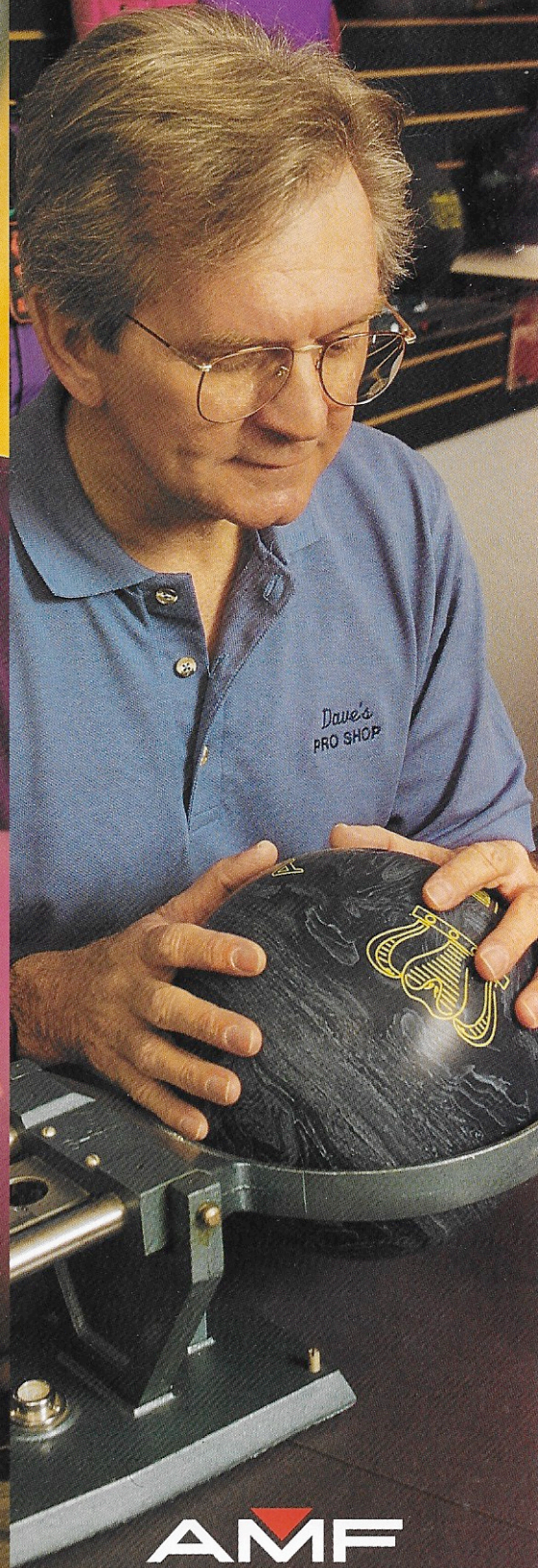
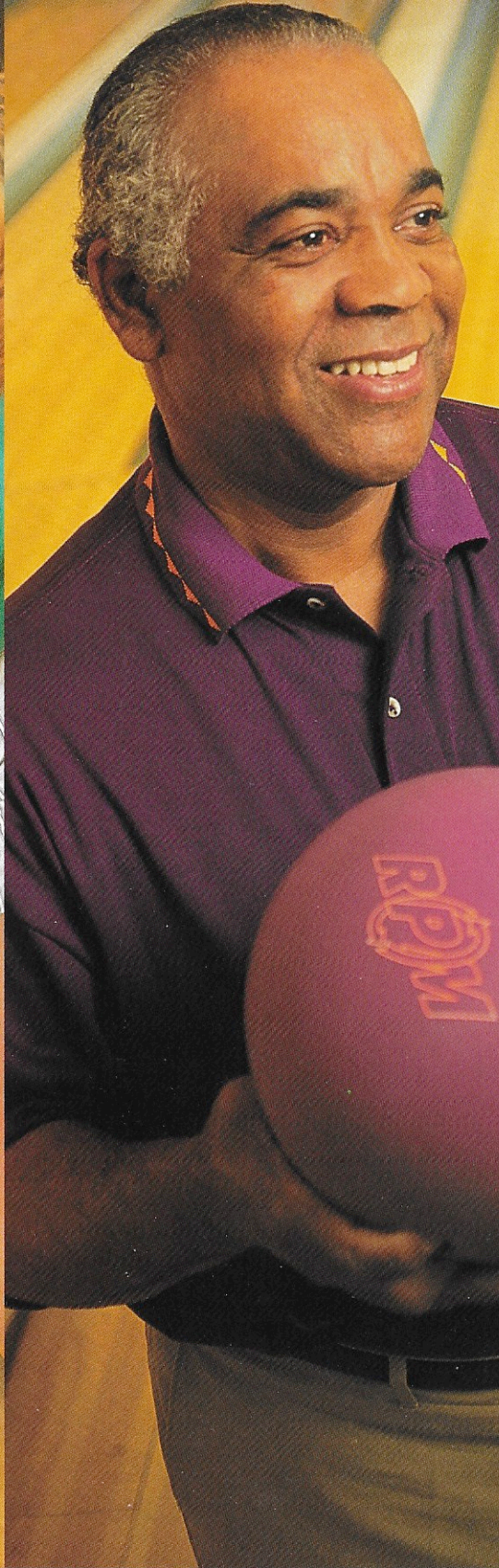

Performance Characteristics: Generates very high revs and a large flare pattern, creating enormous hook with a controllable breakpoint.

Weightblock: Single-core density with dual-density shell; mass concentrated toward center.

NINJA FURY

Performance Characteristics: High moment of inertia creating strong skid and roll with an extreme hook and a powerful move to the pocket.

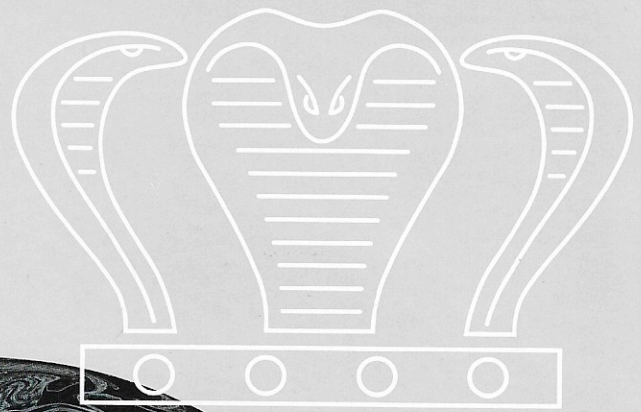

A proven performer, the Sumo remains popular with recreational and league bowlers who want unrestrained pin-scattering capability.

Performance Characteristics: A heavy rolling ball with powerful backend snap. Excellent on heavy oil.

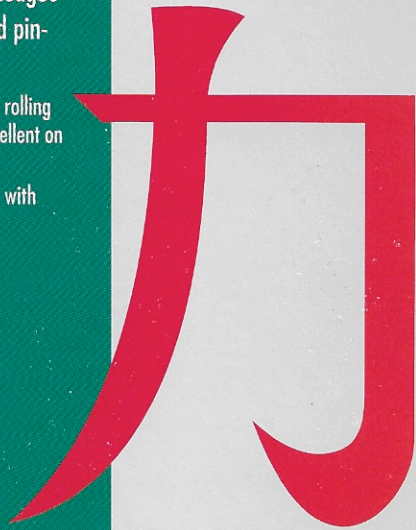
Weightblock: Two-piece construction with patented “flywheel” core.
