- Center Heavy/Cover Heavy: 3.0
- Track Flare Potential: 5.5
- Hardness: 77-79

Tour Edition 2 boasts a medium rg and medium differential rg, yielding a smooth, even reaction on drier conditions.

Danger Zone Tour Edition 3 60-102164

- Features Orange pin
- Available in 15 and 16 pounds
- Two-component design with single-density core
- Conventional Urethane
- Center Heavy/Cover Heavy: 4.6
- Track Flare Potential: 5.6
- Hardness: 78-80

The weakest of the three balls, Tour Edition 3 has been designed for the driest of lane conditions.
