RHINO RE INFORMATION SHEET

CHARACTERISTICS

The Rhino RE's large core and highly reactive coverstock combine to produce a reaction with similar length (skid) but a dramatically, more violent backend reaction and higher hook potential than the Black or Cobalt Rhinos.

The Rhino RE *should not* be thought of as a dry lanes ball. The dynamic nature of the core and inherent reactivity of the coverstock will result in over reaction on truly dry lanes.

The Rhino RE is best suited for medium to oily conditions where a "*delayed*" as opposed to an "*even*" reaction is desired.

The Rhino RE continues the Brunswick commitment to maintain dynamic integrity in the lighter weights. This Brunswick pioneered technology gives bowlers who use 12 and 14 pound equipment the opportunity to obtain the same reaction characteristics that 15 and 16 pound equipment provides.

UTILITY

The Rhino RE is an excellent ball to go to when the lanes start to breakdown and center heavy/ small core two-piece balls begin to hook too early, hook too much, or start to lose hitting power because of excessive early reaction.

The Rhino RE is a good choice as a primary ball (first ball out of the bag) for bowlers with good release mechanics who roll at medium to slow speeds.

DRILLING TIPS

All weights of the Rhino RE can be drilled using standard drilling techniques used on two-piece equipment such as the Rhino Pros.

While there is not "one best way" to drill any ball, drilling the Rhino RE with the same pin, balance hole positions and similar or slightly weaker surface preparation (smoother or more polished), as a bowler's current Teal Rhino Pro will result in an excellent ball to go to when the lanes become too reactive for the Teal.

The Rhino RE has a fairly high track flare potential (lots of flare with the pin on or near the leverage position, see Brunswick Ball Reaction Guide). When using leverage or near leverage pin positions or when drilling for high track players, place the pin at least 3/4" above the finger thumb dividing line to avoid tracking over the finger holes.

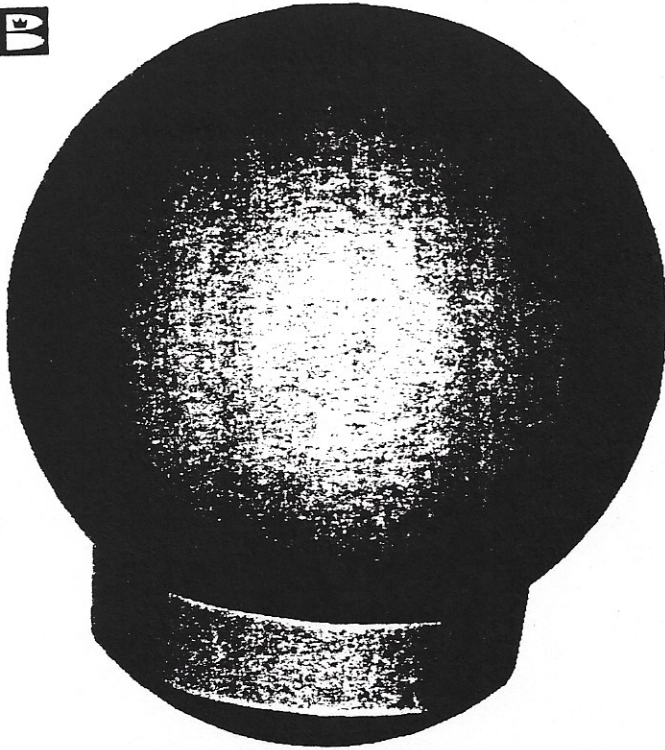

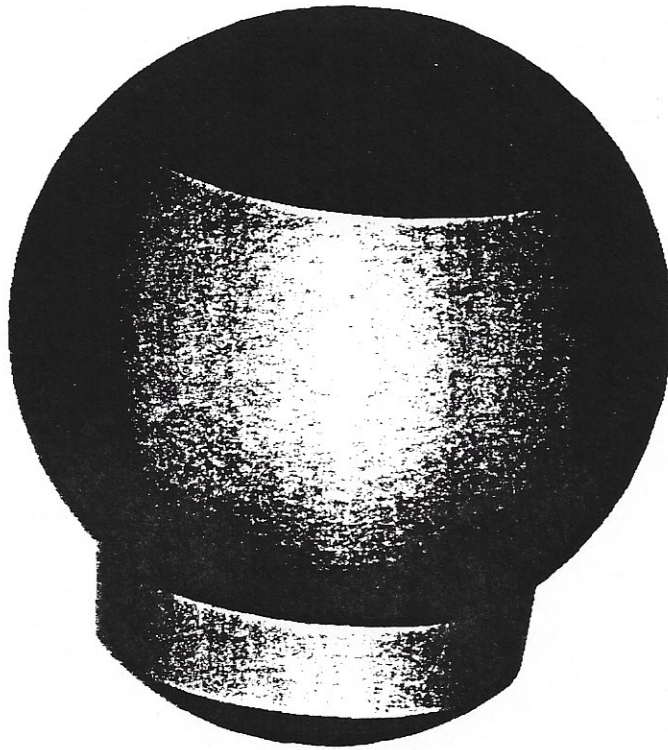
