

Speed Zone Tour edition 2; Green Pin

This ball had an early version of the Speed Demon cover stock with the core from the Tracer Tour edition 1. This core/cover combination provides a ball that is fairly cover heavy with a very low track flare potential. The ball that it is most like is the original Purple Rhino Pro, but with better scoot through the front end. I would suggest very strong drillings for most conditions with this ball (leverage with a 9" hole, for example). Less strong drilling will give a ball that has very little flare and will be good only on the driest conditions. A TE2 with the pin on the bridge line with no extra hole should be the weakest reaction we have next to the Deep Purple Rhino Pro. A ball such as this would be useful only late at night or on the driest conditions.
