

Speed Zone Tour edition 4; Orange Pin

This ball has the same coverstock as the TE3 but has the Defense Zone core. By using a more cover heavy/higher track flare core, the TE4 gets through the heads cleaner than the TE3 but has a stronger backend reaction than the TE2. This should be a good late night ball when the lanes start to fry up but can definitely look a little on the weak side if you try to use it when there is too much oil in the front part of the lane for it. I would suggest using medium to strong layouts in this ball unless you're trying to create something to stay on line when the lanes hook a lot.
