

Speed Zone Tour edition 3; White Pin

This ball is the prototype Speed Demon Zone. It has a core that is dynamically similar to the LT-48 but has a new coverstock that we have been working on to be less sensitive to conditions in the front part of the lane and tends to cover up some variations in the bowler's release. This core/cover combination has matched up well against the Triton Heat in head to head testing, with the Speed Zone having better back end recovery than the Heat. Biggest difference that this ball provides versus our current coverstocks seems to be its ability to make the corner when the lanes start to break down. You should be able to get deeper than you can with an LT-48 and still have the ball recover down the lane. When the Speed Demon becomes available it should be somewhat stronger overall, both a little earlier and a little stronger downlane as compared to the TE3 (tests of the Speed Demon versus the Triton Elite have the Speed Demon somewhat stronger downlane). Any drilling pattern you like should be usable in the TE3.
