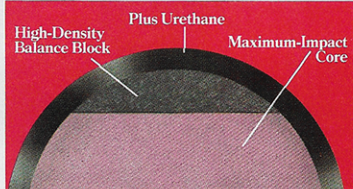
In the process of developing our new ball, we gave our pros test balls with different formulations. We wanted input from the people who are out there bowling every week
