BALL BRAND	PRICE	COVER	HARDNESS	COMMENTS
Magnum 12	*	Soft Urethane	77-81	High Urethane Model proven to work best on medium to heavy oil. Pro Bowlers and Pro Shop operators report this ball may hook as much as any ball on the market, yet does not roll out. Hits very hard.
Magnum 11	*	Soft Rubber/Urethane	77-82	Combination Rubber/Urethane cover works best on house conditions to medium oil. Has won several PBA National titles. Earl Anthony's \$1,000,000 ball.
Magnum 10	*	Soft Rubber	77-81	Porous surface. Works best on medium oil. Does not over-react. Ideal ball for most conditions.
Magnum 5	*	Hard Rubber	86 +	Hard rubber cover over an all-rubber core. High density weight block placed between core and veneer. Best suited for dry lanes.
Manhattan Rubber	*	Soft Rubber	77-81	One-inch thick shell increases drive through pins. Minimal deflection. Has been popular with many Pro Bowlers. Good medium oil ball.
Manhattan Urethane	*	Soft Urethane	77-80	Long skid and sharp hook characterize this ball. May be the hardest hitting Urethane available. Ideal for house conditions up to medium oil. Can be sanded to increase hook.
Gyro I Red	*	Soft Urethane	77-81	Urethane cover over rubber core. Ebonite's hookingest ball. Rolls early, yet hits very hard. Rubber core helps keep pins low.
