MoRich: Colossus Supreme

The Colossus Supreme from MoRich is "colossal". Like the other balls in this line, the Supreme features the proven Colossus shaped core, but utilizes a much denser torque block and a very aggressive "GRABBER" coverstock. This new combination, which produced plenty of flare in our test (7 inches), gives the Supreme incredible hook potential with extreme controllability, making it nearly impossible to throw it through the break point. There is plenty of continuation on the backend and it has a devastating impact on the pins. It's true what MoRich says: "It hits so hard, you can hear the difference." All in all, the combination of the radical "Free Form, MOtion Tuned" core and the highly aggressive coverstock, makes this the fastest revving, most responsive, largest hooking MoRich ball to date.
