

Test Patterns Used

Pattern #1

40 ft. Fresh House Condition with stripped backends on wood lanes Pattern #2

> 45 ft. FIQ Compliant 3 to 1 blend (5 units of oil minimum)



Ball Layout

"Control" layout, from the box drilling instructions, for medium track players. Designed to produce medium track flare, smooth continuous hook with later revs.

Pin to PAP distance 2 1/2"

RC (mass bias) to PAP distance 6 1/4"

About the Tester

Hand: Right

PAP (positive axis point): 5" over by ½" up Rev Rate: 340 rpm Ball Speed at Release: 18 mph Axis Rotation: 45 degrees Axis Tilt: 15 degrees

Maximum Flare Potential: Large

3" of flare in the oil *plus* 4" of flare on the back end equaling 7" of Total Track Flare. This ratio of flare in the oil compared to the backend, results in a ball that reads the midlane and still continues on the back end.

Mass Bias: Strong Asymmetrical

Mass Bias Differential: .011

DeTerminator Spin Time: 7.8 seconds

Hook

Surface preparation: wet sanded with 600 grit paper

Pattern #1- Started the ball on board 35, crossed the arrows at 20, going out to about 11 at the break point.

Motion was controllable as long as it stayed in the heavier oil in the middle of the lane. Read the dry
extremely well and devastated the pins.

Pattern #2- Started the ball on board 35, crossed the arrows at 13, going out to about 4 at the break point. Couldn't throw it through the break point if I wanted to. Motion was very controllable. Never left a 10 pin in over 25 shots, although I did stone a few 9 pins!

Length

Surface preparation: wet sanded with 1200 grit paper and polished

Even though the Colossus Supreme didn't shine easily, the smoothness of the cover with polish, made it much easier to get it down the lane.

Overall review of the MoRich Colossus Supreme

The amount of hook potential in this baby is simply UNBELIEVABLE!!!!! But even with this much hook potential, there is no sign of quit. The overall motion oh the Colossus Supreme is extremely controllable, as the GRABBER cover makes it nearly impossible to throw it through the break point. Carry was phenomenal. It's true what MoRich says, "It hits so hard you can hear the difference". For anybody wishing to play with the BIG DOGS, here's your chance. The Colossus Supreme, with its radical "Free Form, Motion Tuned" core and highly aggressive GRABBER coverstock, is the ticket!
