MoRich: Ravage

For our test we chose the "Sharp Break Point" layout and tested with two different surface preparations (factory polished and wet sanded with 600 grit paper). While producing about 5" of total flare, it was the ratio of flare in the oil (2") compared to the backend (3"), that when combined with MoRich's all new AV (Aotational Angular Velocity) reactive resin coverstock, allowed us to get the ball through the heads with extreme ease. The incredible strength of the mass bias (.018) really showed up at the breakpoint when this thing all but vaulted off the dry. Wet sanding the cover caused Ravage to slow down sooner through the mid-lane and read the end of the oil pattern with consistency. Pin carry was never an issue with either surface, as tripped 4's and tomahawked 10's were abundant. With most full season leauges winding down and final position rounds fast approaching, this is the perfect time for bowlers everywhere to make a stand and Ra*age the competition!
