## MoRich: Total Annihilation

For our test we chose the "Sharp Break Point" layout and tested with two different surface preparations (factory 800 grit matte and polished). The most impressive characteristic of Total Annihilation is without a doubt the unmatched versatility of the first ever MoRich/Brunswick coverstock formulation, C<sub>4</sub> Enhanced Reactivated Super Aggressive Reactive. With 6+ inches of track flare and strong mass bias (.018), one might mistakenly draw the conclusion that this is a hook "early and even" type ball, designed only for heavy oil. **NOT SO!!!** Our test yielded an extremely fast rev rate, nice length (especially when polished) and strong recovery, resulting in yet another reaction type that MoRich can add to their already well rounded line that includes Mayhem (for heavy oil), Onslaught (for medium oil), and Ravage (for medium/light oil). Total Annihilation (for medium to heavy oil) produces "The Overall Hook of Particle with the Explosive Backend of Reactive"!
