TRACK GETS MORE COMPETITIVE WITH NEW 716C



Modifications to the Robot core resulted in the higher differential core used in the 716C. In addition, an upgrade to the veneer resulted in the all "NEW" UMP Gen5C Solid coverstock.

"We have also used a brand new surfacing process, our three-stage factory sanding system," said Figliomeni. "This all-new process for Track removes one sanding stage and therefore uses only three: 500, 1000 and 2000, giving a more aggressive footprint on the lane. Also, remember, if you need a more aggressive reaction, our covers are easy to adjust."
